

## APPEAL

**March 18, 2013.**

To all concerned.

Dear Comrades,

You are aware that few concerned colleagues working at AIR/DD, Patna had approached the Patna Bench of Central Administrative Tribunal by filing OA No. **514** in the year **2002** under the banner of “**Akashvani & Doordarshan Diploma Engineers Association**” for grant of benefits of the ACP scheme of 1999 against the denial of the same by the Government to the engineering employees of AIR/DD. The case was won by them in the Tribunal and the Government’s Writ Petition in Patna High Court and the SLP in Supreme Court of India filed against the order of CAT dated **07.09.2009** were rejected giving finality to the case. The petitioners in the case therein, Shri B.K.Roy, Shri Sudhanshu Kumar and others acknowledge the financial and moral support of the AIR/DD engineering employees all over India in fighting the case in higher courts and sharing the huge expenses.

You are also aware that in spite of the finality reached in the case after the Supreme Court’s order dated **10.01.2011** upholding the decision of CAT & Patna High Court, the Government is trifling with the issue and not allowing the benefits of the ACP scheme to us in accordance with the rules and policy of the scale. In the meantime, strangely enough, the Government has filed a Review Petition in Patna High Court (No. 141/2012) and had prayed to quash the earlier order dated 07.09.2009 of CAT, Patna in OA No. 514/2002 and thereby review its own earlier order dated 25.08.2010 in Writ petition No. CWJC 6451/2010. Although, this may be a mere trifling and delaying tactics by the Government after the case has already been finalised by the highest court, Supreme Court of India, people should not be much complacent and forget the turn and twist in the case of revision of pay scale of Engineering Assistants on par with that of Sound Recordists in which the lower court of CAT, Chennai Bench, in the review petition filed by the Government before it afterwards much after the rejection of its SLP in Supreme Court of India, had rescinded the operative part of its own earlier judgment (which was otherwise finalised by the Supreme Court of India) and the case was once again dragged to Supreme Court.

Against the possibility of any adverse result, now it is envisaged that the ill-intended and malicious move of the Government be fought in the Patna High Court with full might which at the outset requires engagement of **a senior and renowned advocate** for which our petitioners at Patna need fund immediately.

The petitioners at Patna have opened a saving account at SBI, Patna in the name of “**Akashvani & Doordarshan Diploma Engineers Association**” for this purpose and all are requested to kindly contribute generously into this account through Multicity CBS cheques/ DD /Money Transfer etc. immediately.
