These two petitions will come up for hearing in the month of August, 1987. As regards the interim prayer we pass the following order:-

*pending disposal of these petitions the Government shall review all the promotions made to the cadre of Asstt. Engineers in accordance with the judgment of the Tribunal and promote all Diploma Holders who will be entitled to be promoted on the basis of the the review to the Cadre of Asstt. Engineers. If as a consequence of the review of the promotions of the diploma holders who are entitled to be promoted any of the Degree Holders it should be reverted it is open to the Union Government to allow such Degree Holders to continue in the post of Asstt. Engineers by creating, if necessary, extra 'anumerary post or by adopting any other method known to law .
