Sub: Amendment of Recruitment Rules for the post of Technician in All India Radio and Doordarshan.


Please refer to Prasar Bharati Sectt. letter No.M-1/29/2014-PPC/PBRB dated 14th Feb. 2016 seeking clarification on the following:-

"Whether diluting the standard of promotion of Helpers to create promotional avenues for those Helpers who could not pass Departmental Limited Competitive Examination by introducing 10% quota through seniority for promotion to the post of Technician would not compromise the efficiency of the Organization".

2. In view of the above observation, the following comments/clarifications are furnished:-

- i) As per the RRs proposed, eight years of regular service as Helper is mandatory for consideration for promotion to the post of Technician. Hence a Helper, even if doesn't pass the LDCE for the post of Technician, the experience and technical knowledge acquired on field could have made him competent enough to perform the duties of Technician.
- ii) Since helpers will be considered only on the basis of Seniority, the likelihood of their having service more than eight years is very high and hence their vast experience a Helper will suffice the job requirement on Technician. For those Helpers who get promoted through this quota of 10%, organization may conduct an orientation/induction course immediately on their promotion as Technician, to reinforce their on field experience with adequate formal/ academic training.

3. Hence, introduction of 10% quota through Seniority for promotion to the post of Technician would not be compromising the efficiency of the Organization.
