Subject: Salary audit reports.

The Prasar Bharati had assigned the job of analysis of salary audit to the Financial Management Research & Resource Society. The analysis submitted by the FMRRS has brought to the fore cases of over-payment on account of LTC, OTA, Leave Encashment, Wrong fixation of pay etc. The report was discussed in a meeting held under the chairmanship of the CEO with various C.A. firms of Prasar Bharati on 03.01.2012. The CEO has observed that the over payments should be recovered forthwith at one stretch and asked to fix responsibility for such lapses.

A report in respect of All India Radio, Chennai is enclosed. It is requested that expeditious measures to recover the overpayments may be taken and compliance reported to the Inspection Unit so that action taken report could be submitted to the Prasar Bharati secretariat.

Observations:

1. Irregular Grant of MACP –General

Certain cadre of employees were granted higher Pay Scale over and above V CPC Scale not as Government Servant but on furnishing undertaking to become Prasar Bharati employees vide Ministry of I&B Order No. 310/173/97-B(D), dated 25.2.1999. Prasar Bharati employees who were not in receipt of upgraded scale were only extended the benefit under ACP Scheme of V CPC. Those who are in the upgraded scale were not extended the benefit as they are drawing higher scale than the Government Servant.

Prasar Bharati employees who are in receipt of upgraded scale were given higher grade pay with VI CPC over and above Government employees.

As per DOP&T Order No. 35034/3/2010-Estt.(D), dated the 03.08.2010, employees who are in receipt of benefit under ACP Scheme was only entitled for MACP Scheme. Moreover, the conditions stipulated by DOP&T Order No. 35034/3/2010/Estt.(D), dated 03.08.2010 were not followed and orders from Administrative Head/Secretary MIB were not obtained for granting MACP on scrutiny of Service Book of TECHs/SR TECHs/EAs/SEAs/AEs/TREXs/PEXs.

Hence, MACP granting to TECHs/SR.TECHs/EAs/SEAs/AEs/TREXs/PEXs required to be reviewed in the light of the above order accordingly and recoveries effected.
