
Ministry of Information & Broadcasting may please refer to their proposal regarding merger of the posts of Sr. Technician, Technician, Mast Technician and Diesel technician in the Subordinate Engineering Cadre of AIR and Doordarshan in the 6th CPC pay scale of PB – 2 + GP Rs/4200 GP into a single cadre designated as "Junior Broadcast Engineer" applicable only for the Government servants on deemed deputation to Prasar Bharti who joined on or before 05.10.2007.

2. The matter has been examined. This Department has no objection to the proposal of M/o. I&B regarding merger of the posts of Sr. Technician, Technician, Mast Technician and Diesel Technician in the Subordinate engineering cadre of AIR and Doordarshan in the 6th CPC pay scale of PB – 2 + GP Rs.4200 GP into a single cadre prospectively with effect from the date of notification of RRs subject to the following conditions :-

- I. (i) it does not involve any change in the pay scale in any manner whatsoever,
(ii) It does not require re-fixation of pay nor does it involve change in date of increment.
(iii) it does not disturb the next higher post in the hierarchical line of promotion and
(iv) It does not entail any financial implication whatsoever in any form whatsoever.
- II. The aforesaid merger will be applicable only for the Government servants on deemed deputation to Prasar Bharti who joined on or before 05.10.2007. The post will be re-designated as "Senior Broadcast Technician" as recommended by the Cadre Review Committee constituted by Prasar Bharti for restructuring of Engineering Cadre.
- III. The revised post merger sanctioned strength of the single cadre is to be decided taking into progressively reducing sanctioned strength of dying cadre of "Mast Technician" etc.

3. Ministry of I&B is advised that the issue with regard to past merger admissibility of MACP benefits may be suitably considered in consultation with DoPT and due procedure may be undertaken for drafting the RRs in consultation with the Ministries/ Department concerned.

4. This issues with the approval of Competent Authority.
