| | <p>This PT is filed with a prayer to transfer OA No.185/2018 pending on the file of Jaipur Bench to Principal Bench of this Tribunal.</p> <p>It is stated that OA No.4290/2016 and batch on the same issue are pending before the Principal Bench, and if OA No.185/2018 is heard and decided by Jaipur Bench, it would lead to conflicting decisions on the same issue.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent, on the other hand, submitted that OA No.542/2017 which was filed by the respondent herein, in which same question as in OA No.4290/2016 and batch, is involved, has already been transferred, and the present OA is substantially different, and that it has nothing to do with the said batch of OAs.</p> <p>Heard Shri S. M. Arif, learned counsel for the applicants and Ms. Shaefali Sharma, learned counsel for the respondent.</p> <p>The respondent herein filed OA No.542/2017 before the Jaipur Bench claiming certain reliefs, such as, a challenge being to the rules. PT No.195/2018 was filed by the applicants herein stating that the same question is pending adjudication in OA No.4290/2016 and batch before Principal Bench of this Tribunal. Accepting that contention, OA No.542/2017 was transferred to this Bench through order dated 11.01.2019 in PT No.195/2018. Since the same contention is advanced in this PT also, the reliefs claimed in OA No.185/2018 on the one hand, and OA No.4290/2016 on the other hand, were compared.
