

ZIST OF FINANCIAL RULES

FR	SUBJECT
FR 22(I)(a)(1)	<p>*When a Govt. Servant is promoted/appointed to another post carrying duties and responsibilities of greater importance, his initial pay in the higher post is fixed at a stage next above the notional pay arrived at by increasing his pay in the lower post by an increment or Rs 100, whichever is more.</p> <p>*Option is to be exercised within 1 month from the date of promotion.</p> <p>*The benefit is available even if the Govt. Servant is drawing at the maximum of Pay scale.</p>
FR 22(I)(a)(2)	<p>When the new post does not involve assumption of duties and responsibilities of greater importance, his pay is fixed at the same stage if the new post had it or at stage next above his pay (in respect of old post) in the new post.</p> <p>1st Proviso: If minimum of new pay scale is higher than his pay in respect of old post, his pay is fixed at minimum of the new pay scale. (Here, the method of regulation of DNI is not mentioned in the FR)</p> <p>2nd proviso :It regulates the DNI as below:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If the new pay is fixed at the same stage, there is no change in DNI. • If the pay is fixed at higher stage, the DNI will be after 12 months.
FR 23	When pay scale of a post is changed, the holder of the post is treated as if he was transferred to a new post on the new pay scale provided that he may retain his old pay until his next or subsequent increment in the old pay scale.
FR 24	An increment is ordinarily drawn as a matter of course unless it is withheld.
FR 26	Prescription of conditions on which service counts for increments in a time scale.
FR 27	Authority for granting of advance/ premature increments. Order of removal of anomaly in pay by stepping up of pay of senior drawing less pay than his junior is to be issued under FR 27.
FR 28	Fixation of pay by competent authority in the lower pay scale on award of penalty. (not more than the max. of lower pay scale)
FR 29	Reduction of pay on award of penalty.
FR 33	Fixation of pay of officiating officers.
FR 35	The central government may fix the pay of an officiating govt. servant at an amount less than that admissible under these rules.
FR 37	Grant of Personal Pay.
FR 39 & 40	Pay of temporary posts
FR 44	Compensatory allowances
FR 45	Allotment of Govt. Accommodation.
FR 46 & 47	Fees and honoraria
FR 48	Retention of rewards and fees.
FR 55	Leave may not be granted to a govt. servant under suspension.
